Break out your photojournalist skills as you explore the City of Chicago! With bold architecture, amazing parks and lots of lakefront, Chicago inspires tourists and artists alike. But what does it take to capture a city with a camera? Find out as you record your own travel memories on film while learning about photography basics.



Picture It: Capturing Travel is an exciting chance to get first-hand experience in travel photography. Get yourself ready with a Photo 101 workshop and a photo scavenger hunt in downtown Chicago. Share your experience with fellow hostellers by creating a scrapbook for the hostel using your very own photos! You can interview travelers from all over the world about how they record their travels over a spaghetti dinner you've cooked for them. A behind the scenes tour of the School of the Art Institute's Betty Rymer Gallery will teach you about the history of photography and give you the chance to get tips from School of the Art Institute students. You'll also have the chance to check out the photography exhibit at the world famous Art Institute of Chicago. The downtown hostel is a fun and safe base for your explorations with big rooms just for your Girl Scout group, and it's located in the heart of Chicago.

- Ability to walk long distances
- Comfortable walking shoes

Additional overnights at the hostel can be added for \$36.93 Su-Th, \$39.24 F-Sa / person, tax and breakfast included
