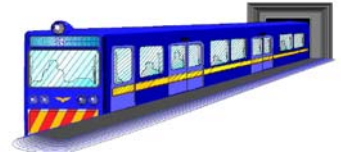




# Lisa says... Take the L to Dinner!!!
