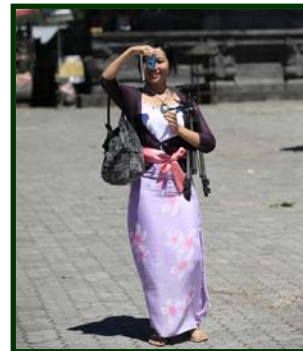


## Capturing Travel: Modern Chicago Chicago through the camera lens!

What does it take to capture a city with a camera? Find out as you record your own travel memories on film while learning about photography basics and modern architecture.

**Picture It:** Capturing Travel: Modern Chicago is an exciting chance to get first-hand experience in travel photography and learn more about Chicago's contributions to the world of architecture. Get ready with a history of the modern architecture movement and a Photo 101 workshop. Put your learning to work in a photo scavenger hunt in downtown Chicago. Create a scrapbook for the hostel using your very own photos to share your experience. Ask world travelers about how they record their travels over a spaghetti dinner you've cooked for them. A behind the scenes tour of the School of the Art Institute's Betty Rymer Gallery will teach you about the history of photography and give you the chance to get tips from School of the Art Institute students. You'll also have the chance to check out the new Modern Wing at the world famous Art Institute of Chicago. Your photos may even become part of a future School of the Art Institute exhibition!
